

⇒ Biodiesel Requirements ⇐

Section 205 of the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 directs the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) to require new biodiesel content labels for all dispensers. The labels must be placed conspicuously on the face of ALL dispensers in full view to consumer as near the price per unit as possible.. Failure to do so may result in FTC fines of up to \$11,000 per day!

⇒ Ethanol Requirements ⇐

Dispensers of 85 percent ethanol-blended gasoline require a label under Federal Trade Commission (FTC) regulations. Penalties for violation of this rule can be as high as \$32,500 per day per violation.

The LA Department of Agriculture now requires labeling dispensers of E-10 blended fuels in Louisiana.
